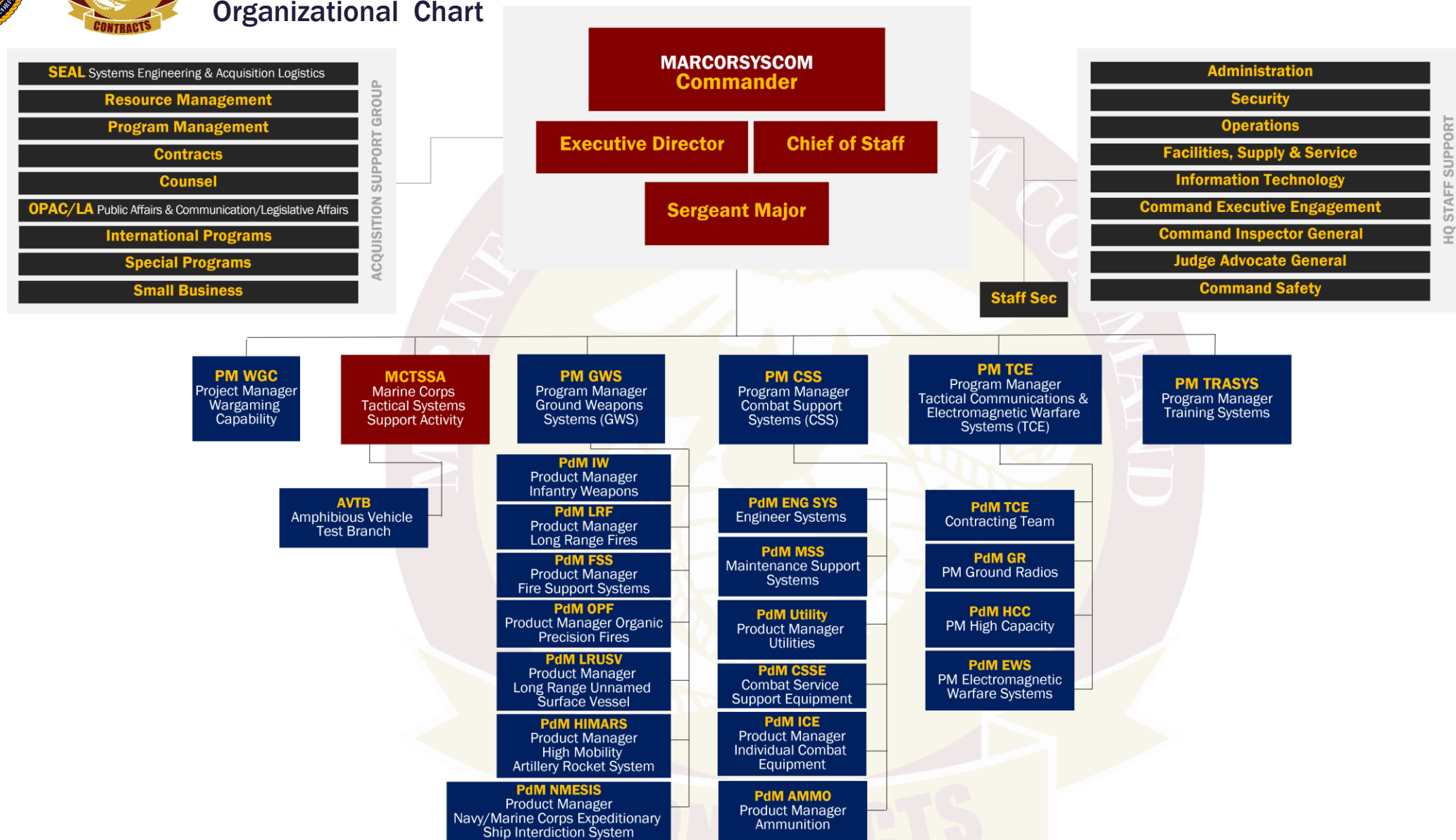

Organizational Chart

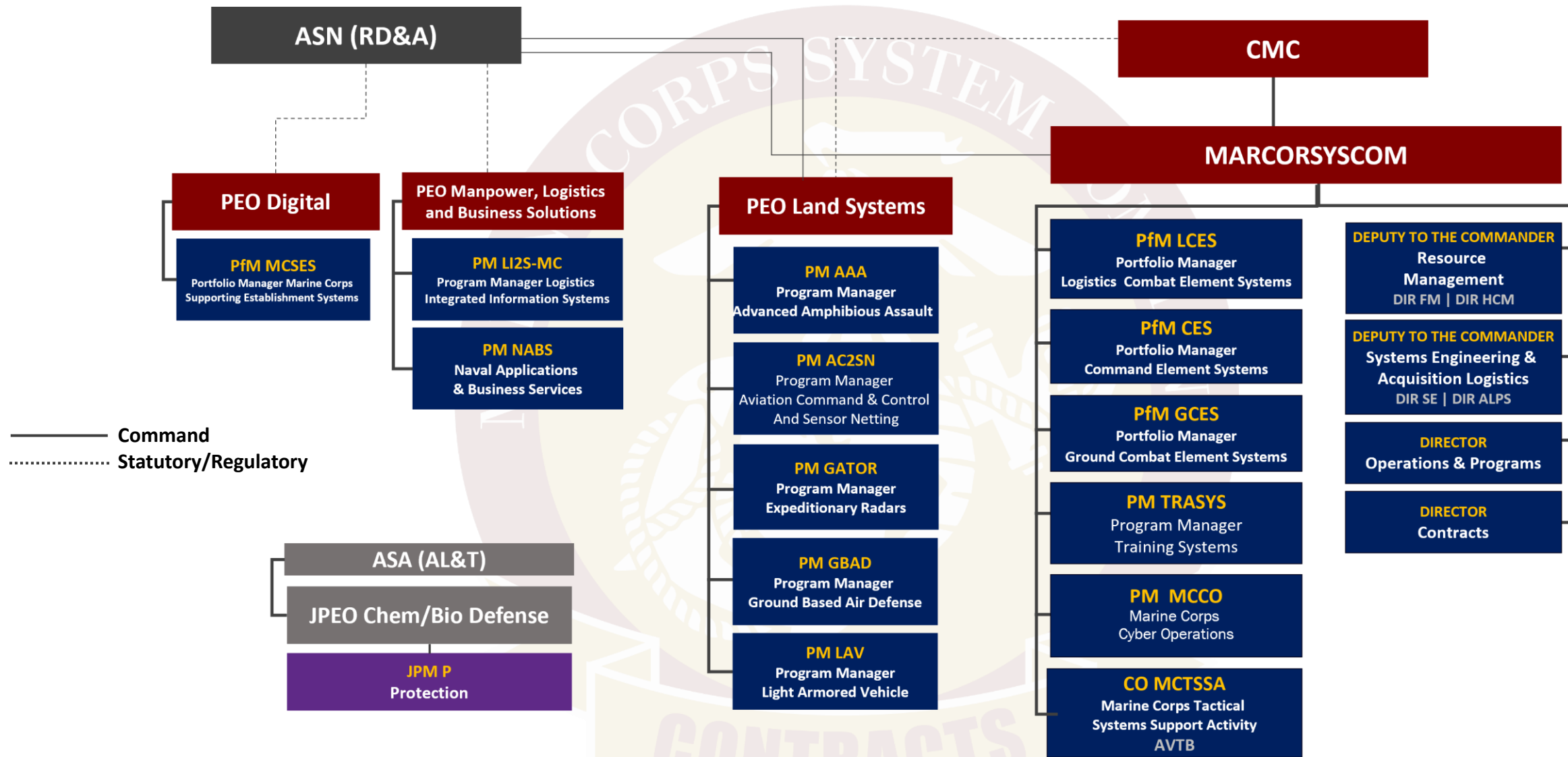

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UNDERSTANDING MARCORSYSCOM CONTRACTS

- The Marine Corps has two Head of Contracting Activities (HCAs) or major buying offices: Marine Corps Systems Command (MARCORSYSCOM) and Headquarters Marine Corps Installations & Logistics.
- In accordance with, Navy Marine Corps Acquisition Regulation Supplement (NMCARS), MARCORSYSCOM serves as the DoN's systems Command for Marine Corps ground weapon and information technology systems programs.
- Locations include: 1) Marine Corps Base, Quantico, VA; 2) Stafford, VA; 3) MCCO in Linthicum, MD; 4) PM TRASYS in Orlando, FL; and 5) MCTSSA in Camp Pendleton.
- FY23 Highlights:
 - Completed 2,017 (includes 93 Other Transaction Authorities (OTAs)) in FY23 actions valued at \$2.740B (includes \$159M OTAs)
 - 63.10% of all actions competed
 - 24.22% of contracts (obligations) to small businesses

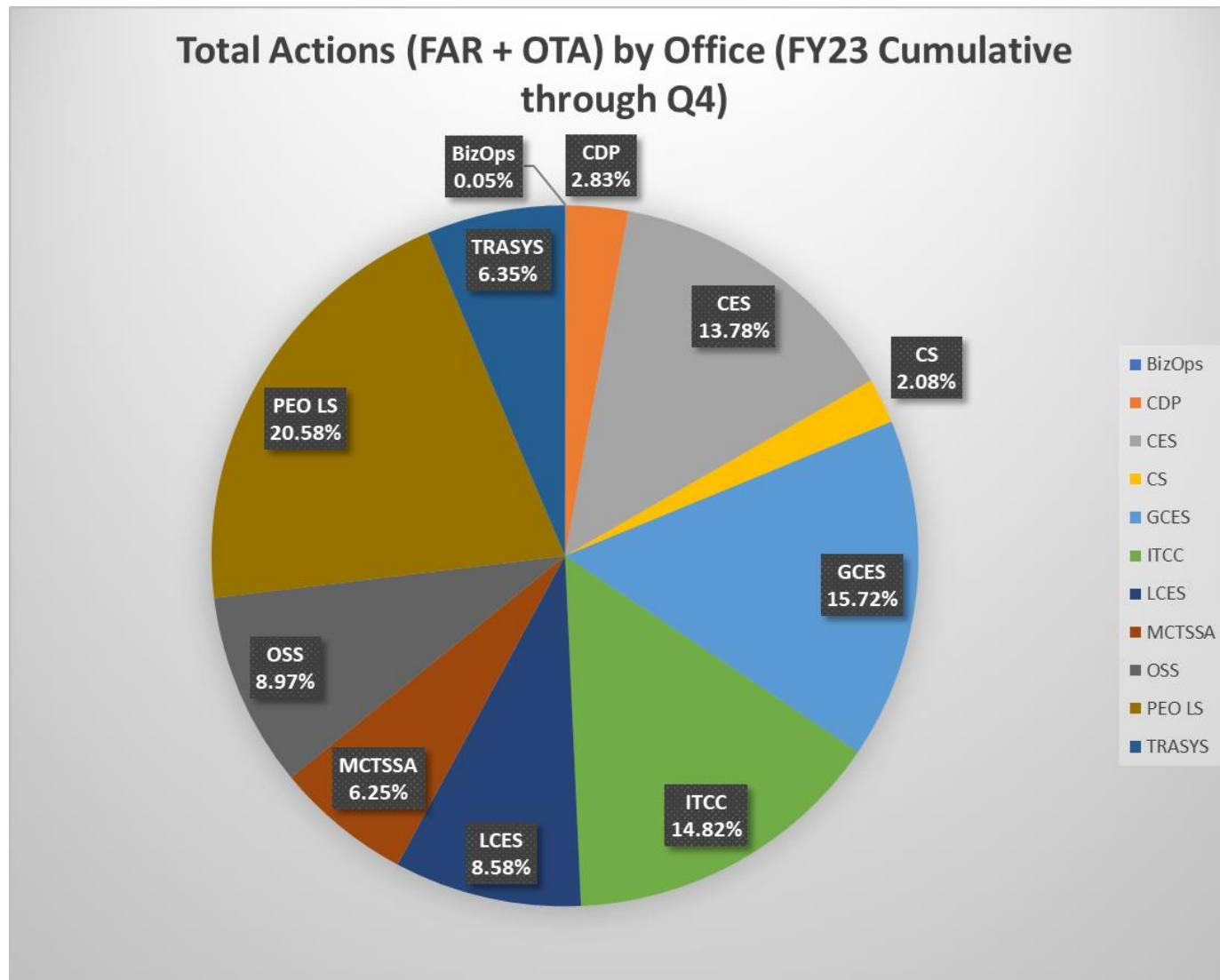

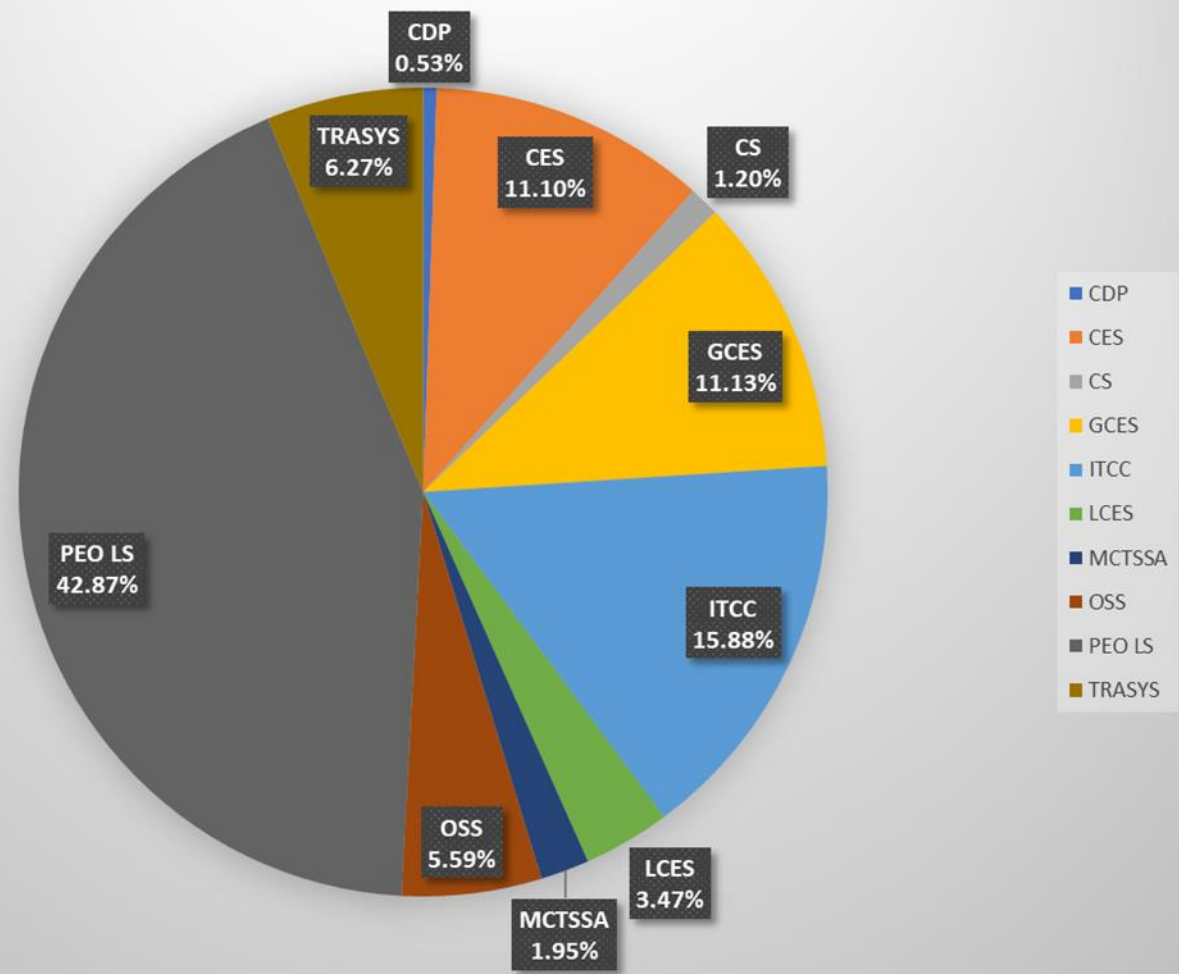

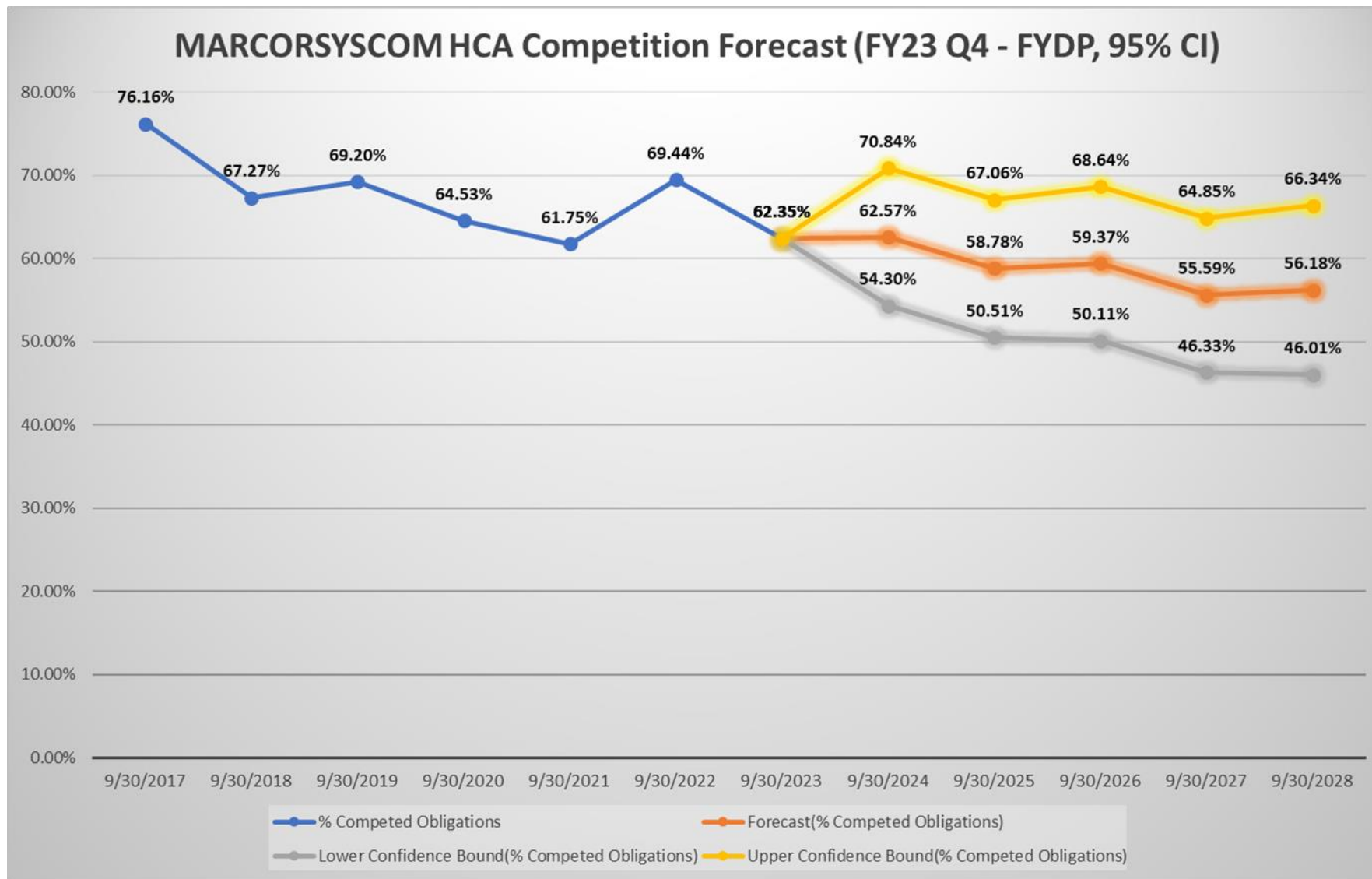

Total Obligations (FAR + OTA) by Office (FY23 Cumulative through Q4)



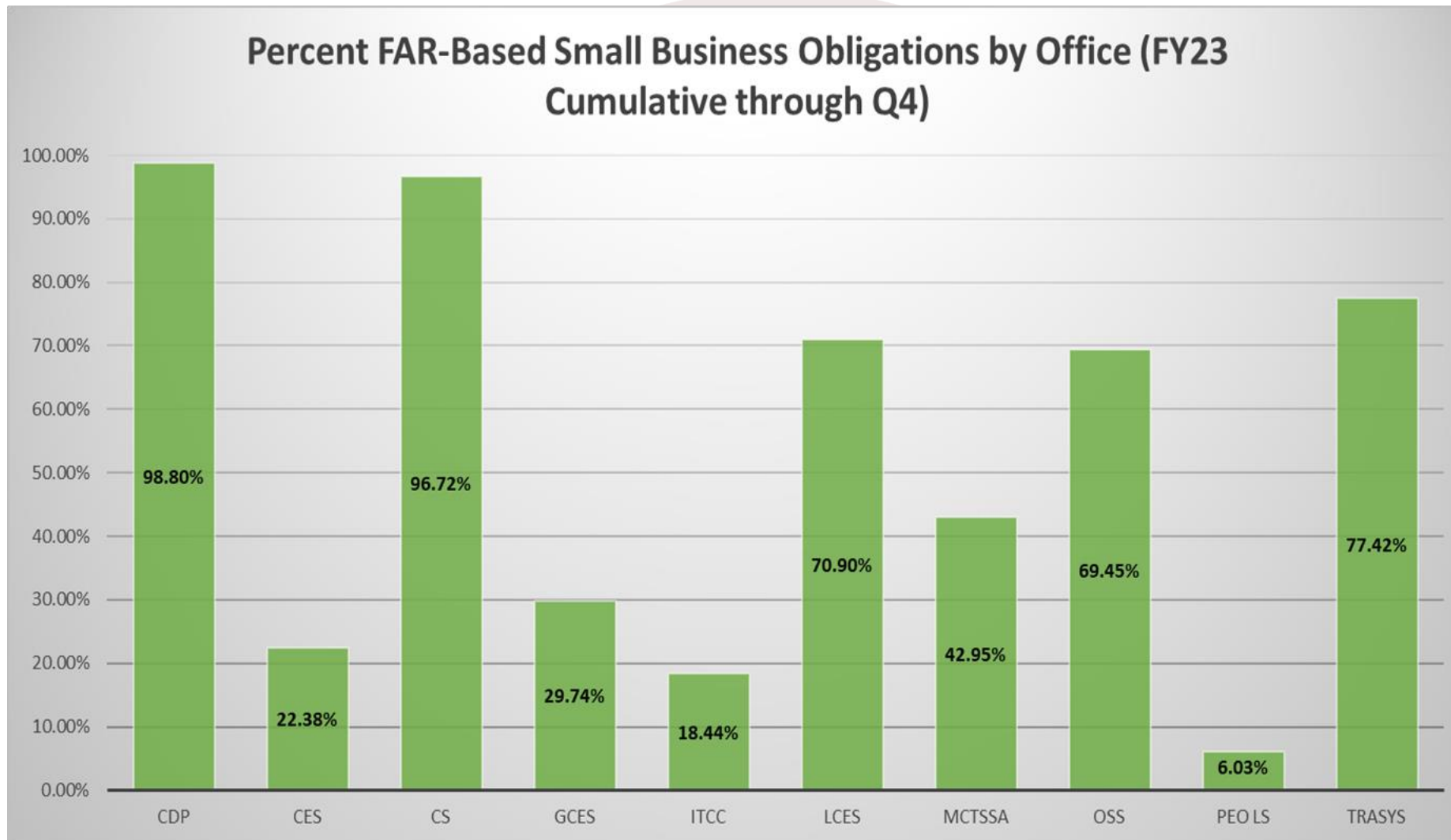
